Deadline Date: Online submission entry deadline **Friday, June 8, 2018**. When deadline is reached the competition is automatically closed to submissions in the www.showsubmit.com program. This is a new online company and you will have to create a new login and password.

NOTE: Notification of accepted artists will be listed on the NAWA Facebook page www.facebook.com/TheNAWA, by June 15, 2018.

Date works to be received at NAWA (hand delivery or shipped): Friday, June 29, 2018, Thursday, July 5, and Friday July 6, 2018, between 10am-4pm

Dates of Show: July 11-August 8, 2018

Reception Date: Thursday, July 19, 2018, 5-7pm

Pack up of Artwork: Hand pick-up, **August 9-10, 10am – 4:30pm**. If art work is not picked up between those dates, **there is a \$10 daily storage fee**.

Shipped works will go out ASAP.

ELIGIBILITY:

This is a national juried small works exhibition, open to all professional women artists age 18 years and older.

NAWA Artists: 2 jpegs: \$45 entry fee. **Non-members:** 2 jpegs: \$50 entry fee.

SPECIFICATIONS:

- Maximum size for 2-D wall works and wall hanging sculpture **INCLUDING** frame: **15" x 15" x 5" maximum size (no exceptions)**.
- No ceiling hung artworks will be accepted. Freestanding sculpture will be accepted. Max. weight 35 lbs., 15" x 15" max size.
- No sawtooth hangers. All works must be wired to gallery standards and must meet professional presentation standards as interpreted by the NAWA Exhibition Committee.
- Plexiglass required for all works on paper. Exception: pastels can be framed under glass.
- Accepted works cannot be substituted and must be available for the duration of the exhibition.
- All works **MUST** be original - no reproductions or giclee prints.

- Do not photograph your work in frames.
- Graphic violence and/or lewd sexual content prohibited. Nudes are acceptable at the discretion of the committee.
- Work will not be hung if it is damaged in transit. We will notify you immediately if your work arrives damaged.
- Unframed canvas art work must have the sides painted (not left white).
- ALL WORKS MUST BE FOR SALE.
- NAWA reserves the right to refuse work not professionally presented. This includes dirt under mats, nicked frames, acidic mats that are discolored, etc.

PREPARATION OF ARTWORK: For best results, make sure your image are no more than **1920 pixels on the longest side @72 dots per inch resolution (DPI). Images should be in JPEG format.**

SALES

1. NAWA receives 30% commission on all sales. Artist will receive 70%.
2. Price of entered work cannot be changed.

DELIVERY/SHIPPING

1. Artists agree to assume all shipping expenses related to exhibition.
2. Shipped work **MUST** include a prepaid bar coded return shipping label (UPS or FEDEX only)
3. **NO COUNTER LABELS and NO USPS POSTAGE STAMPS.**
4. Please ship in sturdy, reusable cartons with adequate packing materials. Please use bubble wrap as opposed to air bags, which tend to deflate before the end of the exhibition.
5. Please do not use oversized boxes for artwork. We cannot store them.
6. Please tape return shipping label, along with the exhibition artwork ID label, and a one page resume, to the back of your artwork.
7. Shipper should be informed: **NO PACKING PEANUTS.** Your work will be returned if it contains packing peanuts.
8. Please mark the name of the exhibition on the outside of the box: **SMALL WORKS.**
9. **If you are hand delivering art work please help us by staying for an hour to help unpack and/or repack artwork.**
10. Accepted artwork may be hand delivered OR shipped – and **MUST** arrive at the NAWA Gallery (Suite 508), on **Friday, June 29 and Thursday, July 5, 2018; and Friday, July 6, 2018**, between 10am and 4pm.

ENTRY AGREEMENT

1. The entry application & payment will serve as the entrant's agreement to all conditions (including the waiver) set forth in this prospectus.
2. Entries will be disqualified for failure to follow these instructions.

WAIVER

I, the undersigned artist, hereby declare my intention to exhibit my artwork as described in my entry form, in the National Association of Women Artists, Inc., "Small Works Summer 2018 Exhibition," to be held at the NAWA Gallery, 315 West 39th Street Suite 508, New York, NY 10018, and to leave said artwork until the specified removal date on the prospectus.

In consideration of the display of my artwork, I hereby declare I am the owner and creator of the original artwork being submitted by me, both as the artwork's physical manifestation and the copyright of artwork. I accept full responsibility for any and all damages, loss, theft, and/or any other casualty of any kind while in the NAWA Gallery's care, custody or possession. I hereby waive any and all claims against the NAWA Gallery, as well as their employees, officers, directors and committee personnel.

Nevertheless, for the purpose of this agreement, I agree that the stated value of the artwork shall be One (\$1.00) Dollar, in the event of any loss or damage to the piece of artwork.

I agree to allow an image of my artwork being exhibited to be used without charge for advertising and/or promotion in the furtherance of the Exhibition, and for any purposes including without limitation traditional media, social media, website, as well as public relations, prior to and/or after the Exhibition.

My work is available for sale at the price hereinbefore agreed. I agree that if my work is sold during the exhibition, I will pay NAWA a commission of 30% and I will retain 70% of the selling price.

Point of Release Clause: the work on exhibition is considered part of the exhibition from point of delivery (either by hand or by mail) and until actual pick up/shipping after close of the exhibition.

I understand that my work may not be hung if it fails to meet professional presentation standards (as determined by the Exhibition committee), arrives, damaged, differs significantly from the jpeg image submitted, is over the depth, width and height limit and (for wall and free standing sculpture) is above the weight, depth, width and height limits.

NAWA retains the right of discretion to decide if artworks do not meet the requirements of the NAWA show standards, or contain any inflammatory or offensive materials.

Labels: NAWA is a non-for-profit art organization, will not list anything other than the name of the artist, title of the work, dimensions, medium and price on the labels.

In the event of a dispute with regard to this Waiver Agreement, we agree that all disputes must be adjudicated in a State Court in the County, City and State of New York (i.e. Manhattan) under the Laws of the State of New York, without regard to choice of Law rules.

Note: The use of the National Association of Women Artists, Inc.'s logo, without prior written permission is prohibited. The use of the registered Trademark Seal and the logo of the national Association of women Artists, Inc. for any personal or business use on any documents, postcards, invitations, and other promotional materials and communications is a violation of law. The letters NAWA may be used by regular juried members (i.e., not Associate or Student members), after their names, on all artworks, signifying their membership.
