The Pastel Society of Western New York Members Juried Exhibition at the Art Center of Yates County is open to the public on February 15, 2022 through March 27, 2022.

Reception:

If the Show Reception takes place, it will be on Sunday, February 20, 2022 from 3:00pm - 5:00pm at The Art Center of Yates County.

Sales: All sales will be handled by The Art Center of Yates County. A 35% commission will be collected on sales. Not For Sale is allowed.

Eligibility and Show Rules:

- Entrant must be a PSWNY Member (this is indicated on your PSWNY membership card) in good standing of the PSWNY by January 24, 2022.
- Entries must be created within the last two years and **not previously shown at this particular venue or any other PSWNY exhibitions.**

- All aspects of entry must be the artist's original work including subject, **photography**, composition, drawing and painting. Using someone else's photograph is not permissible.
- Work submitted must be at least 80% soft pastel. No charcoal allowed.
- Entries may not be produced in any instructional class or workshop.
- Only Two-dimensional works will be accepted into this exhibition.
- No diptych or triptych paintings, mechanical reproductions, photography, crafts, or computer-generated art. No nudes.
- PSWNY does not anticipate damage or theft; however, neither the Art Center of Yates County, nor the PSWNY is responsible for damage or loss of art works submitted for this exhibit.
- Saw-tooth hangers ARE NOT allowed. All paintings must be well framed, and supported by picture wire only. Please make sure that your wire ends are covered with tape to prevent unforeseen injuries to the hanging committee.
- We reserve the right to refuse work not presented in such manner.

Registration

- Show registration and fees will be handled by Show Submit (showsubmit.com)
- Up to **three entries** are allowed. See size restrictions below.
- Size: Three works may be entered if their total width framed adds up to 54" or less. If the total width framed is over 54", two works may be entered.
- An entry fee of \$10.00 per painting is required. You will pay for this on the Show Submit website using your credit or debit card.
- Registration dates: January 1, 2022 through January 24, 2022. Registration will close at midnight, January 24, 2022.

Entry Process

- Go to showsubmit.com and login or create an account if you don't have one
- On the home page of Show Submit, click on Pastel Society of Western New York Online Show

- **You will need to prepare your images to upload before registering.** There is a tutorial on the Show Submit website for doing this.
 - JPEG format
 - Image must be cropped showing no border
 - Resolution should be **72 dpi, set at 1920 pixels on the longest side**
 - The file must be **less than 2MB** when saved as a JPEG. If it is larger when saved at the above specifications, save again at a slightly lower JPEG quality.
 - Name the file in this format: ArtistLastName_PaintingTitle
 - The juror will not see the file name.

Work Pick-up

- Work that is accepted into the show **may not be picked up until the listed pick-up day, and only within the pick-up times.**
- For this show, we will be organizing **one time transport of paintings from Rochester to Penn Yan and back if needed.** You will be responsible for dropping off and picking up your paintings at the designated Rochester location. More information to come.
- If you absolutely cannot pick up your own work please make arrangements for someone else to pick up your work (either from Penn Yann or the designated Rochester location), and notify Denise Rizzo (drizzo28@gmail.com, 585-755-2396) of who that person will be.
